
Introduction

- The highest mountain in Africa (5895m)






Inpatient, Teaching, Research & Clinic services

- Prior Announcements to gather at clinics






Health education on Albinism/XP






Figure 1: Elective students enrolled at RDTC for the calendar year 2016 and 2017


